## **PART ONE: AURAL PERCEPTION** (Singing back what is heard)

## **PART TWO: SIGHT-READING**

Rhythmic Sight-reading:

**\*\*You must be able to start yourself off and complete a higher level of a rhythmic clapping sight-reading exercise (much like the sample on the next page).**

## **PART THREE: PERFORMANCE OF SELECTED SONG**

You will perform the vocal line of the part that you are auditioning for of a selected song by yourself to a CD accompaniment (as if you were to sing a solo). Make sure that you know when your own part enters, be sure of all pitches and rhythms, and if the selected song is in a foreign language, please know the correct pronunciation!

## **PART FOUR: APPROPRIATE DRESS - DRESS CODE APPLIES:**

5 points out of the total score you will receive after completing your audition is for dressing appropriately. Please dress appropriately during your audition. Jeans, shorts or any clothing that is torn and not professional will be looked down upon and will cost you those 5 points. This is Honor Choir - please “look” the part you are auditioning for!
